## 1. ICT Training to Public School Teachers at Barakhshetra

A two-day ICT Training Program for public school teachers of Barakhshetra Municipality was successfully conducted on March 30–31, 2026. The training was organized by the Rotary Club of Itahari with support from Rotary International District 3292 under its Basic Literacy & Education Project.



The program aimed to enhance teachers' digital skills and promote the effective use of information and communication technology (ICT) in classroom teaching. Participating teachers received hands-on training on basic computer operations, Microsoft Office applications, internet use, and digital teaching tools.

The training emphasized practical learning and interactive sessions, enabling teachers to integrate modern technology into their teaching practices. Participants expressed appreciation for the initiative, noting that it would significantly improve the quality of education in their respective schools.
